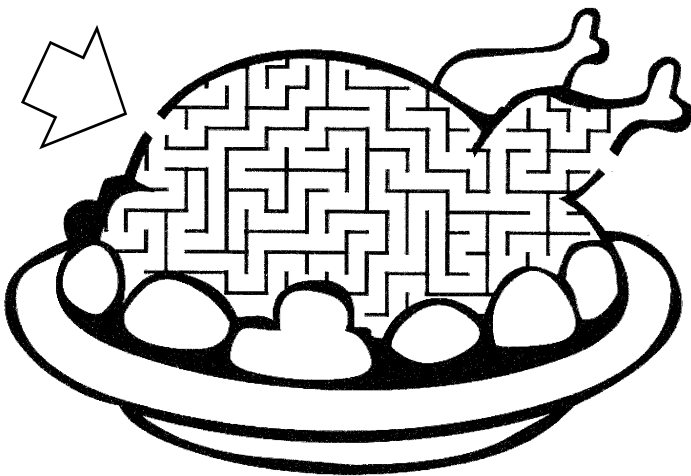

The Steering Wheel Sudoku puzzle uses nine non-repeating letters instead of numbers. The answer is below.

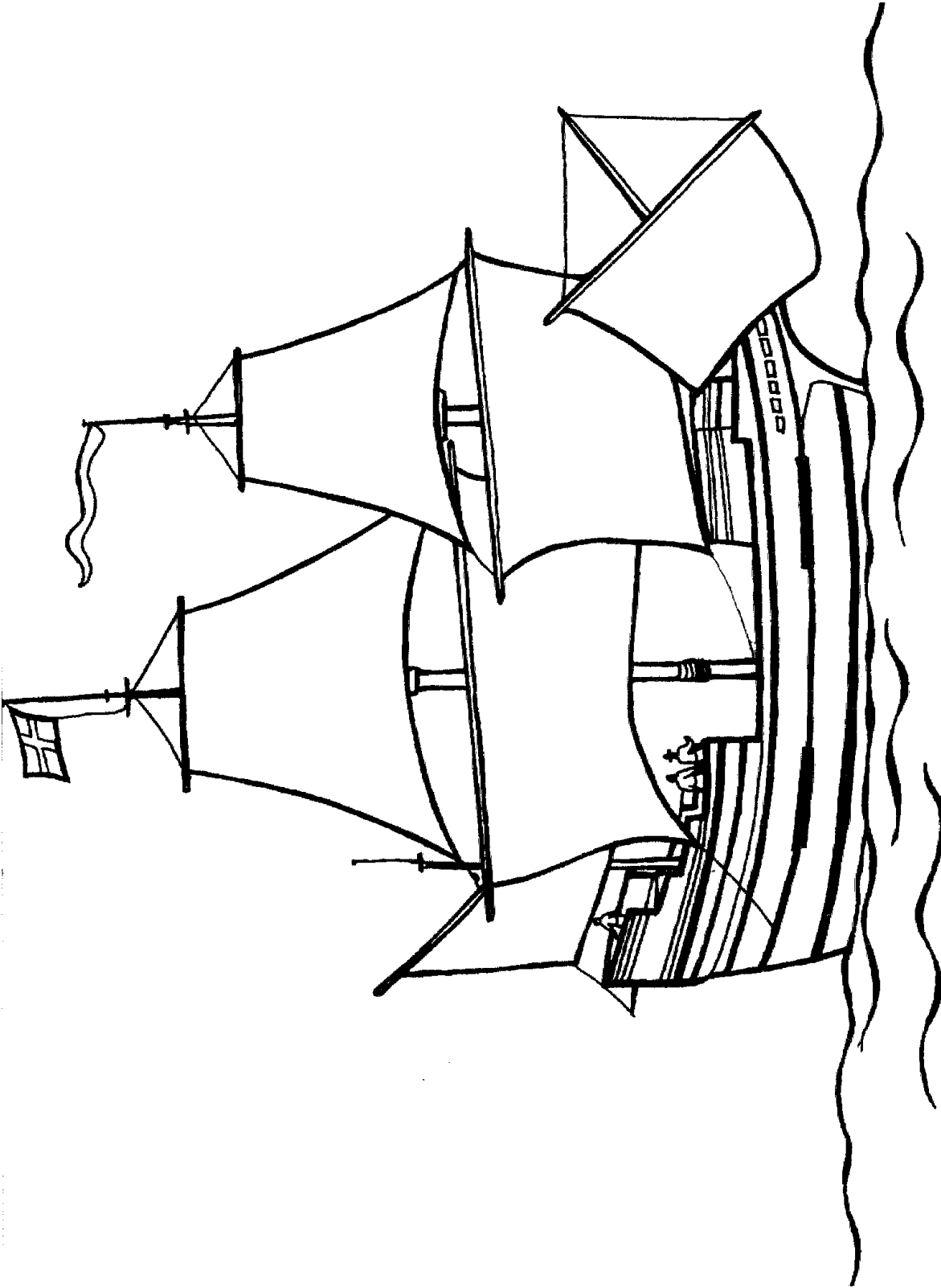
